“Kings and the United Kingdom”

I Samuel 1-I Kings 11, I Chronicles 1-II Chronicles 10

Open questions—

1. What is the basic difference between “Follow the Leader” and “King of the Mountain”?
2. Who is the best leader you have ever followed? What made the worst leader you ever followed the worst?

Dig questions—

1. Who was the last judge and the predecessor of the kings?
2. Why did the people of Israel want a king? (I Samuel 8) Did God want them to have one? What warning did He give the people about having a king?
3. Who became the first king? What was different about him? Was he a good king? (I Samuel 9, 15)
4. Who was the second king and what was different about him? Was he a good king? (I Samuel 16, II Samuel 2 and 5,
5. Who was the third king? Why was he chosen king? Was he a good king? (I Kings 1)
6. What did God promise about the future kingdom of Israel? How has that come true? (II Samuel 7:12)

Reflect questions—

1. Does God always listen to us? Does he always give us what we want? What is the warning the story of the kings for us regarding God answering our prayers?
2. If you are a leader for the Lord, what should you learn from the kings? If you are helping to choose leaders for the Lord, what do these stories help you keep in mind?
